My breakthrough will not come through more "stuff." It will only come through faith in God's Supernatural provision. ([Ps 37:16-17](#), [Ecc 2:26](#), [Prov 10:22](#))

God's job is to pay all the bills. My job is to keep giving my life away for free. ([Mark 9:35](#), [Matt 20:28](#), [Prov 10:22](#), [Luke 6:27-31](#), [Prov 22:4](#)). (10/2015: "You pray, I'll pay.")

If I am going to be a "man of faith", I have to actually BE a faith-filled man. ([2Cor 5:7](#), [Zech 4:6](#))  
"Pastors who do not pray cannot lead the Church." -PT

I am a man of prayer; I listen for your voice in every moment. ([Luke 9:35](#), [John 10:27](#), [Rom 8:14](#))

I give everything as I am led. I am a good, faithful steward. ([2Cor 9:11](#))

The burden is not on my shoulders to build Jesus' Church; Jesus alone carries the burden to build His Church. ([Matt 16:18](#))

My Deliverer is coming. ([Rev 22:12-13](#), [1Peter 5:10](#))

My family loves Jesus; they are safe in His hands. Their FUTURE is safe in His hands. I have nothing to fear. ([Ps 37:25-26](#), [Dt 28:4](#), [Ps 112:2](#), [Prov 22:6](#))

I have peace that transcends all understanding, because I trust my God. ([Prov 3:5,6](#), [Php 4:6-7](#)). If I am losing my peace it indicates that I'm not trusting my God.

I am not a complainer. Complaining is worshipping the enemy's plan for my life. Instead, I praise God that He has spoken- I will not want. ([100 verses on complaining](#))
